2021 Assembly Bill 75

Assembly Amendment 6

2021 ASSEMBLY BILL 75

2021 Assembly Bill 75 prohibits a person from labeling a food product as, or selling or offering for sale a food product that is labeled as, any type of meat product, "meat," or a similar term unless the product: (1) is derived from the edible part of the flesh of a **mammal**, **bird**, **reptile**, **amphibian**, **mollusk**, or **insect**; and (2) does not include cultured animal tissue that is produced from animal cell cultures.

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 6

Assembly Amendment 6 provides that the prohibition in the bill does not apply to a food product that is derived from the edible part of the flesh of a **freshwater or saltwater fish** (and does not include cultured animal tissue that is produced from animal cell cultures).

BILL HISTORY

Representative Moses offered Assembly Amendment 6 on June 22, 2021. That same day, the Assembly adopted Assembly Amendment 6 and passed Assembly Bill 75, as amended, on voice votes.
