## 1995 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 9

January 13, 1995 – Introduced by Representatives Harsdorf, Brandemuehl, Otte, Vrakas, Ziegelbauer, Musser, Ladwig, Underheim, Grobschmidt, Ainsworth, Seratti and Kaufert, cosponsored by Senators Zien, Drzewiecki and Buettner. Referred to Committee on Criminal Justice and Corrections.

**Relating to:** providing for an advisory referendum on the question of enacting the death penalty in this state.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This joint resolution calls for an advisory referendum at the general election in November 1996 on the question of enacting the death penalty in the state of Wisconsin for certain types of intentional homicide, as the legislature may prescribe by law.

Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That there be submitted, for advisory purposes only, to the voters of this state at the general election to be held in November 1996, the following question:

"Shall the death penalty be enacted in the State of Wisconsin for certain types

of homicide, as the legislature may prescribe by law, committed by persons who act with the intent to kill?"
