1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 234

- March 27, 1997 Introduced by Representatives M. LEHMAN, BRANDEMUEHL, ZUKOWSKI, RYBA, HUBER, GRONEMUS, MUSSER, GOETSCH, MEYER, POWERS, BOCK, ALBERS, TURNER, BAUMGART, OLSEN, HAHN, GROTHMAN and HUEBSCH, cosponsored by Senators C. POTTER, RUDE, PLACHE and PANZER. Referred to Committee on Colleges and Universities.
- 1 AN ACT *to amend* 15.94 (4) of the statutes; **relating to:** the term of the student 2 member of the state technical college board.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Currently, one member of the technical college system board must be a student enrolled at least half-time and in good academic standing at a technical college who is at least 18 years old and a resident of this state. The student member is appointed for a 2-year term.

This bill provides that the student member does not cease to be a member of the board if he or she graduates during his or her term.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 15.94 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 4 15.94 (4) One student enrolled at least half-time and in good academic

- 6 for a 2-year term. The governor may not appoint a student member from the same
- 7 technical college in any 2 consecutive terms. If the student member loses the status
