



1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 626

December 30, 1999 - Introduced by Representatives SKINDRUD, ALBERS, CARPENTER, GOETSCH, GRONEMUS, NASS, PLOUFF, PETTIS, STONE, SUDER and TOWNSEND, cosponsored by Senator A. LASEE. Referred to Committee on State Affairs.

1 **AN ACT to create** 36.11 (41) of the statutes; **relating to:** prohibiting the
2 expenditure of University of Wisconsin System funds to send family and friends
3 of faculty and staff and nonessential personnel to events.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the board of regents of the University of Wisconsin (UW) System to ensure that no general purpose revenue or program revenue, other than from gifts, is used to pay any of the costs associated with sending family members and friends of faculty and staff and nonessential personnel to conferences, seminars, competition and other events.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 36.11 (41) of the statutes is created to read:
5 36.11 (41) PROHIBITED EXPENDITURES. The board shall ensure that no general
6 purpose revenue or program revenue, other than from gifts, is used to pay any of the
