3         Whereas, Robert M. Thompson was born in Madison on November 25, 1927;

5         Whereas, he married the former Ruth H. Lanzendorf on August 14, 1948, in  
6     Arlington, and was the proud father of Karol (Bob) Tomlinson and grandfather of  
7     Eric Tomlinson and Kari Tomlinson; and

8         Whereas, Bob owned and operated the Columbia Electric in Dekorra for many  
9     years; and

10         Whereas, in 1980 Bob was appointed United States marshal for the Western  
11     District of Wisconsin, and during his tenure received the Justice Department's Silver  
12     Star for Bravery Award for his management of the nearly 15,000 Cuban refugees  
13     during the Cuban deployment at Fort McCoy, and was the highest decorated civilian  
14     law enforcement officer in the country at this time; and
