



## 2001 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 21

February 15, 2001 - Introduced by Senators ERPENBACH, BAUMGART, BRESKE, COWLES, DARLING, DECKER, FARROW, GEORGE, HANSEN, HUELSMAN, SCHULTZ, SHIBILSKI, WIRCH and ZIEN, cosponsored by Representatives BALOW, ALBERS, BERCEAU, BOYLE, GRONEMUS, GROTHMAN, GUNDERSON, HEBL, HUBLER, JOHNSRUD, KREUSER, KRUG, F. LASEE, MEYERHOFER, PETROWSKI, PETTIS, PLALE, PLOUFF, POCAN, POWERS, REYNOLDS, SCHNEIDER, SHERMAN, SHILLING, SKINDRUD, SINICKI, STASKUNAS, STONE, SYKORA and YOUNG. Referred to Committee on Privacy, Electronic Commerce and Financial Institutions.

1     **Relating to:** urging the Wisconsin congressional delegation to work to enact  
2           legislation that would remove social security numbers from hunting and  
3           fishing license applications.

4           Whereas, in 1996 Congress passed, and the President signed, the Personal  
5     Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996 (PRWORA); and

6           Whereas, PRWORA contained numerous provisions geared toward  
7     strengthening state laws relating to child support enforcement and paternity  
8     establishment; and

9           Whereas, PRWORA, among other things, requires states to implement  
10    procedures under which the state has the authority to withhold, suspend, or restrict  
11    the use of driver's licenses, professional and occupational licenses, and recreational  
12    licenses, including hunting and fishing licenses, of individuals owing past-due  
13    support or failing, after receiving appropriate notice, to comply with subpoenas or  
14    warrants relating to paternity or child support proceedings; and
