

2003 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 26

March 21, 2003 – Introduced by Representative Wasserman, cosponsored by Senator Robson. Referred to Committee on Health.

Whereas, 41 million Americans do not have health care coverage; and
Whereas, 8 out of 10 of the uninsured are in working families that cannot afford
health insurance and are not eligible for public programs; and
Whereas, the Wisconsin Department of Health and Family Services has
reported that in 2001, 11% of Wisconsin residents were uninsured, and nearly 17%
of Milwaukee residents were uninsured; and
Whereas, the uninsured live sicker and die younger when they go without the
health care they need; and
Whereas, a slow economy, higher unemployment, and rising health costs mean
that more Americans are becoming uninsured in our community; and
Whereas, it is important to recognize the urgency of seeking solutions to one of
America's greatest problems; now, therefore, be it
Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That the members of the
Wisconsin legislature declare the week of March 10 to 16, 2003, "Cover the

- 1 Uninsured Week" in the state of Wisconsin, and commend this observance to all
- 2 citizens.
