



2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 246

March 18, 2005 – Introduced by Representatives WIECKERT, KREIBICH, NISCHKE, JESKEWITZ, GRONEMUS, PETTIS, AINSWORTH, OTT, GUNDERSON, PETROWSKI, VOS and HUEBSCH, cosponsored by Senator REYNOLDS. Referred to Committee on Colleges and Universities.

1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 38.04 (4) (am); and *to create* 38.04 (4) (f) and 38.22 (7) of the
2 statutes; **relating to:** admission standards for, and the curricula of, health
3 occupation programs offered by technical colleges.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill directs the Technical College System Board, within a specified period, to develop admissions standards and a standard curriculum for each health occupation program offered by the technical college districts and ensure that all district boards adopt them.

5 38.04 (4) (am) The Except as provided in par. (f), the board shall not consider
6 any course of study for approval under par. (a) that has not first been approved by
7 the district board.
