



## 2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 720

October 3, 2005 - Introduced by Representatives POPE-ROBERTS, PARISI, SINICKI, BERCEAU, BLACK, POCAN, LEHMAN and MOLEPSKE, cosponsored by Senators HANSEN, ERPENBACH and WIRCH. Referred to Committee on Education.

1     **AN ACT** *to amend* 119.04 (1); and *to create* 115.28 (28) and 120.12 (27) of the  
2             statutes; **relating to:** requiring each school district to adopt a policy on the  
3             idling of school buses.

***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

This bill requires each school board to adopt a school bus idling policy for school bus drivers in order to minimize the time that school buses idle on or near school grounds. The bill directs the Department of Public Instruction to recommend to school districts ways to accomplish that goal.

***The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:***

4             **SECTION 1.** 115.28 (28) of the statutes is created to read:  
5             115.28 (28) SCHOOL BUS IDLING RECOMMENDATIONS. Recommend to school  
6             districts ways to limit the idling of school buses on or near school grounds and the  
7             exposure of pupils and bus drivers to diesel exhaust.
