2           University of Wisconsin Badgers football team.

3           Whereas, Barry Alvarez began coaching the University of Wisconsin Badgers  
4     football team in 1990; and

5           Whereas, Barry Alvarez has won more games (118) on the University of  
6     Wisconsin sidelines than any of his predecessors and is just the 10th coach in Big Ten  
7     Conference history to win at least 100 games at the same institution; and

8           Whereas, Barry Alvarez's teams have won at least a share of 3 Big Ten  
9     Conference (1993, 1998, 1999) and Rose Bowl Championships; and

10          Whereas, Barry Alvarez is the only coach in the history of the Big Ten  
11     Conference to win back-to-back Rose Bowl Championships; and

12          Whereas, Barry Alvarez has registered a 8-3 (.727) bowl record, the highest  
13     winning percentage in college football history for coaches with at least 11 bowl  
14     appearances; and
