2 Whereas, Martin F. Stein came from a modest background, the son of
3 immigrant parents who came to this country with little more than the clothes on
4 their backs; and

5 Whereas, Marty Stein worked as a child to support his family's struggling
6 grocery store; and

7 Whereas, Marty learned the value of hard work and was filled with the spirit
8 of the American dream; and

9 Whereas, he started a small pharmacy with a friend, which grew into a large
10 enterprise and then followed other business ventures like Stein Health Care
11 Services Inc., which provided health services and included stores like Stein Optical,
12 the leading provider of eye care in the Milwaukee area; and

13 Whereas, Marty never forgot his roots, playing a central role in the Jewish
14 community, from his role as chairman for the United Jewish Appeal to his meeting
15 with the Prime Minister of Israel in 1988, he earned an international reputation; and
