



2005 SENATE BILL 609

February 20, 2006 – Introduced by Senators HANSEN, A LASEE, CARPENTER, MILLER, ROBSON, ROESSLER, TAYLOR and WIRCH, cosponsored by Representatives NELSON, LEHMAN, KAUFERT, BERCEAU, BOYLE, FIELDS, FREESE, GRONEMUS, HUBLER, MOLEPSKE, SHERIDAN, TURNER, POCAN and TRAVIS. Referred to Committee on Veterans, Homeland Security, Military Affairs, Small Business and Government Reform.

1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 21.19 (8); and *to create* 20.465 (1) (am) of the statutes;
2 **relating to:** body armor for national guard members and making an
3 appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the adjutant general or a designee to provide the latest version of the highest quality body armor to every resident who is a member of the national guard or of a reserve component of the U.S. armed forces called into the U.S. armed forces combat duty.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 20.465 (1) (am) of the statutes is created to read:
5 20.465 (1) (am) *National guard armor.* A sum sufficient to provide body armor
6 to members of the national guard and reserves under s. 21.19 (8).

7 **SECTION 2.** 21.19 (8) of the statutes is amended to read:
