



## 2007 ASSEMBLY BILL 187

March 19, 2007 - Introduced by Representatives MOULTON, M. WILLIAMS, GRONEMUS, GOTTLIEB, MUSSER, SUDER, SHERIDAN, LEMAHIEU, MOLEPSKE, OWENS, VOS, STEINBRINK, WOOD, MURSAU, HRAYCHUCK, NERISON, GUNDERSON, GUNDRUM, KAUFERT, JESKEWITZ, BIES, NEWCOMER, SMITH and PETROWSKI, cosponsored by Senators ERPENBACH, OLSEN, PLALE, DARLING, SCHULTZ, KEDZIE, WIRCH and GROTHMAN. ### *Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

Under current law, with certain exceptions including an exception for residents under the age of 16, no person may fish in this state unless the person has a valid approval that authorizes fishing. The Department of Natural Resources (DNR) issues various fishing licenses including resident and nonresident annual fishing licenses, two-day sports fishing licenses for both residents and nonresidents, 15-day fishing licenses for nonresidents, and four-day fishing licenses for nonresidents. This bill requires DNR to also issue one-day fishing licenses to residents and nonresidents.
