



2007 ASSEMBLY BILL 768

February 6, 2008 – Introduced by Representatives GOTTLIEB, JESKEWITZ, ALBERS, A. OTT, BALLWEG and NASS, cosponsored by Senator GROTHMAN. Referred to Committee on Transportation.

1 **AN ACT to renumber** 343.245 (3m) (title) and 343.245 (3m) (a) and (b); **to amend**
2 85.103 (6); and **to create** 343.247 (1) of the statutes; **relating to:** extending the
3 employer notification program administered by the Department of
4 Transportation to noncommercial motor vehicle drivers.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the Department of Transportation (DOT) administers an employer notification program. The program permits an employer of a commercial motor vehicle driver to register the driver's name with DOT and to be informed by DOT whenever a traffic-related conviction, suspension, revocation, cancellation, disqualification, or out-of-service order is recorded on the person's driving record.

This bill extends the employer notification program to allow employers to register employees who do not operate commercial motor vehicles if the employee's employment responsibilities include the operation of any motor vehicle.
