



2013 ASSEMBLY BILL 264

July 15, 2013 - Introduced by Representatives VRUWINK, KLEEFISCH, OHNSTAD, KAHL, WACHS, BALLWEG, MARKLEIN and JORGENSEN, cosponsored by Senators KEDZIE and SCHULTZ. Referred to Committee on Natural Resources and Sporting Heritage.

1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 23.33 (2) (c) 2. of the statutes; **relating to:** requirements for
2 attaching a plate to an all-terrain vehicle or a utility terrain vehicle.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) administers the laws regulating all-terrain vehicle (ATV) and utility terrain vehicle (UTV) registration and operation. Generally, a person operating an ATV or UTV must register the ATV or UTV with DNR, unless certain limited exemptions apply. A person who operates an ATV or UTV exclusively for agricultural purposes or on private property may register the ATV or UTV for private use. A person who registers an ATV or UTV for public use may operate the ATV or UTV on an ATV trail or other established public ATV corridor. A person who registers an ATV or UTV for public use must attach his or her own plate, displaying the registration number of the ATV or UTV, to the rear of the vehicle. He or she must also affix a registration decal, furnished by DNR, to each side of the vehicle. This bill eliminates the requirement that a person who registers an ATV or UTV for public use must attach a plate to the ATV or UTV.
