



2013 ASSEMBLY BILL 913

April 3, 2014 - Introduced by Representatives HULSEY and YOUNG. Referred to Committee on Tourism.

1 **AN ACT relating to:** increasing state funding for the arts and making an
2 appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill increases the funding for aid to exceptionally talented groups and individuals who are engaged in or concerned with the arts; for services that further the development of the arts and humanities; and for grants and loans for arts incubators by \$5,000,000 in the 2014-15 fiscal year.

4 (1) STATE AID FOR THE ARTS. In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the
