2015 SENATE BILL 399

November 20, 2015 - Introduced by Senator L. TAYLOR, cosponsored by Representatives GOYKE, BERCEAU, BOWEN, KESSLER and C. TAYLOR. Referred to Committee on Judiciary and Public Safety.

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 175.53 of the statutes; **relating to:** prohibiting certain law
2 enforcement practices or policies.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill prohibits a law enforcement agency from establishing a policy or engaging in a practice of enforcing laws in a manner that is intended primarily to raise revenue.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 175.53 of the statutes is created to read:
4 **175.53 Prohibited policy or practice; law enforcement.** No law
5 enforcement agency, as defined in s. 165.83 (1) (b), may establish a policy or engage
6 in a practice of enforcing civil, traffic, or criminal laws in a manner that is intended
7 primarily to raise revenue for the agency, the state, or a political subdivision, as
8 defined in s. 175.46 (1) (e).
