## 2017 SENATE BILL 434

October 9, 2017 - Introduced by Senators KAPENGA, FEYEN, CRAIG, STROEBEL and NASS, cosponsored by Representatives KUGLITSCH, R. BROOKS, FELZKOWSKI, TAUCHEN, PETERSEN, JARCHOW, KREMER, HUTTON, GANNON, JACQUE, ALLEN and THIESFELDT. Referred to Committee on Elections and Utilities.

1     **AN ACT** *to repeal* 16.75 (12); *to renumber and amend* 16.953; and *to create*  
2           16.953 (1) of the statutes; **relating to:** state agency goals for the generation or  
3           purchase of electric energy derived from renewable resources.

***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

This bill eliminates the requirement that the Department of Administration establish goals for certain state agencies to generate or purchase electric energy derived from renewable resources. The bill specifies that the elimination of that requirement does not require the modification or termination of any current contract into which a state agency entered in order to meet those goals.
