5	Whereas, it is estimated that 45,750 deaths from this disease will occur this
6	year; and
7	Whereas, pancreatic cancer is the ninth most common cancer in women and the
8	tenth most common cancer in men; and
9	Whereas, this year, it is estimated that there will be 1,130 new cases of
10	pancreatic cancer in Wisconsin; and
11	Whereas, pancreatic cancer is the third-leading cause of cancer deaths in the
12	United States and Wisconsin; and
13	Whereas, the good health and well-being of the residents of the state of
14	Wisconsin are enhanced as a direct result of increased awareness about pancreatic
