



2019 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 88

January 29, 2020 - Introduced by Senators SCHACHTNER, LARSON, RINGHAND and SMITH, cosponsored by Representatives EMERSON, BILLINGS, BOWEN, CABRERA, CONSIDINE, HEBL, OHNSTAD, SARGENT, SHANKLAND, SINICKI, SPREITZER, STUBBS, SUBECK, VRUWINK and ZAMARRIPA. Referred to Committee on Senate Organization.

1 **Relating to:** recognizing Bikers Against Child Abuse for its outstanding work in
2 creating safer environments for abused children.

3 Whereas, Bikers Against Child Abuse, also known as B.A.C.A., is an
4 international nonprofit organization dedicated to alleviating the fears of abused
5 children by providing them with physical and emotional support when they feel the
6 most vulnerable; and

7 Whereas, B.A.C.A. members work with local and state authorities and with
8 mental health professionals to try to reduce the trauma experienced by abused
9 children; and

10 Whereas, the children who have faced the suffering and distress of child abuse
11 consistently demonstrate heroism, and B.A.C.A. members take great pride in
12 helping these children work to achieve the rewards offered by a healthy life; and

13 Whereas, these young heroes are truly deserving of special recognition for their
14 determination and bravery in facing their trauma; now, therefore, be it
