1 **Relating to:** proclaiming October 2023 as Manufacturing Month.

2 Whereas, the manufacturing sector in Wisconsin is a major contributor to the
3 economic engine of the state, providing over \$68 billion per year in economic output,
4 or 20 percent of the state's total gross domestic product; and

5 Whereas, the manufacturing sector in Wisconsin employs nearly one in six
6 workers in the state through roughly 92,000 companies; and

7 Whereas, Wisconsin proudly leads the nation as a top state in manufacturing
8 jobs per capita, according to the most recent U.S. Census data; and

9 Whereas, Wisconsin's manufacturing sector has remained robust and resilient,
10 creating a total of 9,300 new manufacturing jobs in the past year alone; and

11 Whereas, Wisconsin continues to support its manufacturing sectors by
12 investing in programs to help the manufacturing sector succeed and expand the
13 talent pipeline, including supporting programs like registered and youth
14 apprenticeships, which provide on-the-job training, as well supporting programs to
15 encourage more youth to consider a career in manufacturing; and
