2021 WISCONSIN ACT

AN ACT relating to: implementation of talent attraction and retention initiatives.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions.

(1) No later than 30 days after the effective date of this subsection, the chief executive officer of the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation shall do all of the following:

(a) Submit a plan to the joint committee on finance

describing in detail the corporation's plan for making the expenditures required under 2021 Wisconsin Act 58, SECTION 9149 (2), with respect to initiatives for the attraction of talent to and retention of talent in this state under s. 238.155.

(b) Ensure that the corporation begins making the expenditures required under 2021 Wisconsin Act 58, SECTION 9149 (2).

* Section 991.11, WISCONSIN STATUTES: Effective date of acts. "Every act and every portion of an act enacted by the legislature over the governor's partial veto which does not expressly prescribe the time when it takes effect shall take effect on the day after its date of publication."
